Notes for Caregivers

- Reservations are available online in advance or at the park until capacity with a maximum of **12 guests**.
- Park admission is not included and is required to participate in this experience.
- This tour is about **30 minutes** in a classroom setting with the opportunity for multi-sensory experiences.
- Please arrive to the Animal Interactions & Tours building in Nairobi 15 minutes prior to tour start time for check-in with park ambassador.
- Restrooms and water are available at the tour check-in location.
- Due to the nature of being at an amusement park, the environment can be noisy and crowded. Guests are encouraged to bring any personal sensory related tools for their visit at Busch Gardens.
- A quiet space and limited number of sensory related tools are available by request for the duration of the tour.



Expectations for the Sensory-Friendly Animal Insider

- I will stay with my group at all times
- I will go to more than one location
- I will follow directions
- I will keep my hands and feet to myself unless I have permission to touch an animal or materials
- I will use gentle touch on animals
- I will use my quiet voice when in the classroom



When it is time for my tour, I will go with my group to the **Animal Interactions & Tours building** to meet the zoo keeper.





I will patiently wait with my group for the **zoo keeper** and other guests under the tent.

I might hear **loud sounds** or be near **other people**.





I can get a **drink of water** and go to the **restroom** while I wait for the tour to start.

I might have to **wait in a line** if other people are also getting a drink or visiting the restroom.

The zoo keeper will ask everyone to use hand sanitizer before going to the classroom. I can ask to wash my hands in the restroom if I do not like hand sanitizer.



When the zoo keeper is ready and all of the other people have arrived, I will stay with my group to go to the classroom.

I might hear loud sounds or be in a crowd on the sidewalks.

When I am in the classroom, I will sit on a chair, carpet square, or bean bag chair.

I can move between the seats as long as I do not approach the animals.

I will see animals and hear the zoo keepers talk about each one.

I might see a mammal, a bird, or a reptile. I might see some small animals or some bigger animals.

I might get permission to gently touch an animal or have to keep my hands to myself.

I might hear an animal make a **loud noise**. I can wear my own **headphones** or ask the zoo keeper to borrow a pair.

I might **smell** things that are different. I can try breathing out of my mouth.







If I am allowed to **touch** the animals, I will be **gentle** and follow directions from the zoo keeper.

I will only touch the animals when the zoo keeper gives permission.



I can interact with the **sensory table** at any time during the tour. I might have to **share** with other people in the classroom.







If I need a break during the tour, I can go with someone from my group and a Busch Gardens employee to a quiet space.
I will follow all safety signs.



When the tour is over, I will leave the classroom with my group.

The zoo keepers will ask everyone to **wash their hands** at the restroom. This is very important after interacting with animals.

I might stay at Busch Gardens with my group or I might go home.
